1. Superintendents must check in and verify that all exhibits have an entry tag. Any exhibit without an entry tag will not be judged. Superintendent will reject any exhibits of low quality. All exhibits will be examples of useful farm, agricultural mechanics or or-namental projects owned and made by the exhibitor of an FFA Chapter.
2. No names are to be on the front of the displays.
3. Entries will be limited to Asotin County FFA Chapters. Top of Class awards will be awarded to the top exhibit in each class. A plaque will be awarded to the top exhibit in each class. A belt buckle will be awarded to the best Over All Ag Mechanic exhibit.

A plaque will be awarded to the Best Overall Greenhouse entry. Top FFA Greenhouse exhibit will receive \$30 from Master Gardeners and Reserve FFA Greenhouse exhibit will receive \$20 from the Master Gardeners. To be eligible for the award, participants must have received a blue ribbon.

For members enrolled in Photography Projects. Entries limited to pictures taken during the current year. Entries must be firmly attached to poster board, matting or suitable substitute. Margins should not exceed 2 1/2 inches. Use dry mount tissue, rubber cement or other suitable substitute to attach. Un-matted or framed entries not allowed. Entries with glass not accepted. Photo story exhibits to be mounted all together on one board. Type of camera and kind(s) of film used in photographs is to be indicated on the pre-entry forms due March 6. Limit of 10 entries total. Pictures must be 5"x7" or 8"x10". Best overall photography exhibit will be awarded a plaque and a rosette and the creative Arts will be awarded a plaque and a rosette.
