
PARADE RULES AND REGULATIONS

Any group not following the rules will be asked to leave and will not be invited to participate in any future parades.

- Due to safety issues involving the throwing of candy and other items. Groups may provide people to walk along the parade route and pass out items to the crowd.
- NO HOT RODDING
- No discharging of firearms or simulated type of noise or fireworks are allowed.
- Parent or guardian must accompany any children entered in the parade under the age of 18.
- No water guns, water balloons, or other water throwing devices will be allowed.
- All horse entries: please provide own clean up units.
- It is the guardian's responsibility to attend to their horses/animals.
- All units: please maintain a forward motion with approximately 40 feet between each entry.
- Smoking and use and/or possession of drugs, alcoholic beverages or illegal substances are forbidden.
- No profanity is allowed along the parade route.
- Drivers of motorized vehicles must have a valid driver's license.
- All entries are required to have insurance and testify to this by signing the application form.
- The Asotin County Fair Parade Committee reserves the right to withdraw any unit of which costume or performance does not conform to the standards of reasonable public taste.
- An approved fire extinguisher shall be accessible to the driver.
- Handholds MUST be available for people in sitting positions, and more secure supports should be accessible for those standing.
- All decorative materials must be manufactured so as to be effectively fire retardant.

Asotin County Fair & Rodeo, Asotin County Commissioners, City of Asotin and the Parade Committee do not pay mileage, meals, lodging or any other expenses incurred by participating entries.
