Please Read & Sign Below Parade Rules & Regulations 2025

- 1. Candy may be passed out but not tossed out due to safety concerns. Groups may provide people to walk along side of their entry and pass out candy and other items to the crowd.
- 2. No firearms, fireworks, or weapons of any kind are allowed during the Parade.
- 3. No Hot Rodding or Burning Rubber on streets is allowed during the Parade.
- 4. A Parent, Guardian, or Leader must accompany any children entered in the parade under the age of 18 years old.
- 5. No Water Guns, Water Balloons, or Other Water Throwing Devices Are Allowed during the Parade.
- 6. All Horse Entries <u>MUST</u> Provide Their Own Clean-up Units. <u>Awards will be given to those Entries who provide pooper scoopers</u>.
- 7. Parade Entries with ANIMALS must have a Guardian at all times to attend to their horses, or Animals.
- 8. All Parade Entries Must Maintain a forward Motion and <u>stay at least</u> <u>50-ft behind the entry in front of you.</u>
- 9. The Smoking of any kind of Cigarette, Drugs, or Alcohol is Illegal and Is Not Allowed.
- 10. Profanity along the Parade Route Is Not Allowed.
