Minutes:

Peggy asked for any other corrections or additions to the minutes dated 3-27-2019.
Minutes dated 3-27-2019 approved as corrected per Peggy.

Treasurer's Report:

Peggy Reported – Bills need to be paid

Motion was made by LaNae to pay this bill, seconded by Ron. The Motion Passed.

Charlotte Reported all is Good-Nothing to Report

Extension Office:

Kim Belanger reported Master Gardeners and Beekeepers request 2-full vendor spots in Floch Hall for fair. Kim Suggested to Barb to let each livestock superintendent know - can get help from 4-H/FFA members – **But No Parent Can Help.** Kim stated entry online for fair entries closes on April 11th, 2019. If deadline is missed will allow entries up until April 22nd, 2019. All tack must be brought into the fairgrounds by Wednesday April 24th, 2019. Kim is requesting Wi-Fi for horse show weekend - Keith will provide this for them. Keith will work up the arena, shavings are in totes and can be used for the eight horse stalls.

Keith reported he has back-up timers from the Lewis Clark Saddle Club in case the fair/rodeo timers do not arrive on time.

Open to the Public:

Ron Carnahan cannot paint lines in the parking lots for us.

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Committee Reports

Royalty: Queen Samantha Elben reported she is looking forward to the horse show. Samantha requested new riding boots – she went to North 40 to get a quote and bring it to the Fairboard for approval, however she was informed that the Fair account had been closed. Samantha requested a check to purchase the riding boots. Samantha will be attending the style review on April 18th, 2019 and she will be passing out awards.

Samantha reported the princess for a day will be riding in the parade and attending the royalty luncheon.

Kacie Elben asked about budget for the luncheon – Peggy told her to get what she needs at URM – except drinks, Coca Cola will provide those. Gift bags are being made by Peggy for the luncheon.

Keith requested need to buy 2-10ft gates. Cost for each \$138.00. Needs 30 T-post 6ft long. Cost \$4.97 each.

Steve informed Keith he has some T-post he will donate to the fair. Keith reported that the toilets are in at Early Bird and ready to pick-up. Neil will pick-up the toilets and install them in the Bennett Building for us on Saturday April 13th, 2019

Local Rodeo:

Trophies are done for the local rodeo.

Keith reported from Carlie that the call-in entries went very well. Keith will go to Clark Communications regarding the 25 walkie talkies to be used during the fair & rodeo.

Fair Theme:

Jamie handed out forms with four Fair Theme Ideas for 2020. Board members circle the one of your choice.

Jamie will not vote. Jamie has permission to vote for Shan via text from Shan in her absence.

Vendors:

Peggy reported all vendor spots are filled.

County Commissioner:

Chris reported the County Commissioners will help with the Cowboy Breakfast.

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Old Business:

Arlene reported she will get the required health permit needed for the cowboy breakfast and asked to be reimbursed. The Grand Marshal jackets are being embroidered and handbooks are out in Pullman.

Barb reported she located a 3x5 FFA Flag to purchase, need to talk with Glenn Landrus first. She can get 5-8ft poles and 5 hangers at Home Depot. Motion was made to let Barb purchase flag poles and hangers and reimburse her, seconded by Chad. Motion was voted on and passed.

Jamie reported parking campers for Fair is on Sunday April 21st, 2019 and Monday April 22nd, 2019 from 5pm-7pm. LaNae and Chad will help.

LaNae reported polo shirts, long sleeve shirts, and jackets have been ordered. She will pass them out to fairboard members when she receives them.

Rod & Debbie Hostetler gave permission for flag ladies to park trailers on their land.

New Business:

Cindy inquired about fairboard receiving state money – was told it has not been received at this current date April 10th, 2019.

Peggy reported the phone in Boyd Hall for the Extension Office will be turned on by TDS on Friday April 12th, 2019.

We received quote from Doug Renfro for new roof/gutters on swine & sheep barns. Cost \$2,909.90 A motion was made by Jamie to get the new gutters & roof fixed, seconded by Ron. Motion was voted on and passed.

Barb reported she received an email from Ken Cook regarding his daughter Carlie – she broke her ankle is requesting permission to have someone else show her steer. Fairboard mentioned she will have to be in the showring standing in the corner while her animal is being shown. Barb will inform the Beef Superintendent and Beef judge. A motion was made by Jamie to allow a 4-H or FFA member to show Carlie's Steer for her with her standing in the arena, seconded by Chad. Motion was voted on and passed.

Barb requested that Brooklyn Ausman have permission to bring another steer to fair due to her steers health issues. Motion was made by chad to allow Brooklyn to bring another steer, seconded by LaNae. Motion was voted on and passed.

Rustebakke Veterinary Clinic will have a vet on duty at livestock weigh-in for fair.

LaNae requested information regarding getting zip codes. Shan not at meeting, no information available at this time.

Arlene requested information on how to purchase carnival wristbands. Peggy reported have to go to fairboard or carnival websites to purchase them or contact Peggy to buy them.

Jamie asked if anyone was going to paint the lines for parking on Chris Seagroves property. No one contacted to do this yet.

Jamie reported she will contact Sherwin Williams for quote on paint in exchange for passes to the fair & rodeo.

Chad reported he bought the paint to paint behind the new bleachers in swine arena barn for new construction of relocation of Raise the Barn sign. Cost \$553.53. Steve will provide the spray gun.

LaNae reported the outside bathrooms on the main level need to be cleaned. Barb reported she will mow the park area before fair.

Peggy reported the Asotin Fire Department will spray down/wash out the livestock barns on April 12th, 2019 at 6pm.

Kim reported the dog show went very well.
