The Lions lot was also mentioned as a possibility either for parking or for carnival workers.

We were told that we could attend the Asotin County Commissioners Meeting and see if we could use their lot for either for parking or campers. We would pay the county a yet to be determined amount for the use of the lot and we would not lose any revenue on the parking.

Kim, from the 4H Extension Office was a little concerned with the campers being down below because a lot of the kids are being dropped off for animal washing and barn duty in the morning.

In conclusion: We also would need to help figure out what we would do with the working from the carnival since they were using the county area to park and if we used it, they would need to find alternative places to park.
