

Asotin County Fairboard Zoom Meeting February 24th, 2021

Meeting called to order at 6:30pm

4-H/FFA Boosters: Charlotte reported the boosters will be having a meeting. If the Methodist Church doesn't use their vendor spot, the boosters would like to. The boosters are asking if they can operate during fair from 7:00am-2:00pm. If they have the benefit roping they would like to do Bud's Cook Shack for that and for rodeo.

Extension Office: 4-H online new changes that integrates with fair entry. Should do a couple of the training sessions to learn about the changes. There are free pallets of hand sanitizer available to pick up in Wahluke, 2100lbs on a pallet. Should have a backup plan in place for fair. Clarkston School is on A/B schedule so it shouldn't be a problem at fair time per Cami. 4-H is still not open for face to face yet. Judy Floch is available to help with fair entry.

Sales Committee: Warren reported lamb & goat weigh in was successful. They are starting to have a plan on how to have the sale.

Superintendents: Mike the swine superintendent reported that he has talked to Glenn Landrus about the pig alleyway the FFA will be fixing. When it warms up he will get the swine barn painted. Some of the Paint will be donated. Shawn Balzer will help paint the swine barn. Steve Mullins offered his paint spray gun if needed.

Horse Leaders Council: Reported that they will meet in the next couple of weeks. Horse Show Dates are April 17 & 18th 2021. Nicole reported that she is reaching out to find sponsors to help pay for the horse judge. They have some ribbons & prizes left over from last year they can use. Trying to reach out to local horse judges. Under 20 Kids enrolled in Horse Project. Do they think they will need the Ramblers 4-H club to run the cook shack during horse show?
Horse medals class what day do they want it on Saturday of fair or during the horse show?

Dog Show: The dog show will be April 10th. Location TBD. Maybe Bennett Building or City Park.

Minutes from February 10th meeting approved as read.

Treasurers Report: Bills to be paid. CHS Primeland Diesel \$13.09, Motion was made by Steve to pay the bill, seconded by Chad. Motion passed.

Royalty: Heidi/Moresa reported the royalty crown, belt buckle and chaps have all be ordered and paid for by sponsors. Going to Pendleton on Friday March 5th to get Kendall a cowboy hat, this too is being paid for by a sponsor. Ryan Rogers asked Heidi why doesn't the royalty travel to Hermiston Rodeo since he has a business there and he is a royalty sponsor. We will add to the list of events, Rodeo is August 11th-14th.

Cowboy Breakfast: It was suggested we raise the cost for the breakfast to \$7.00 a plate. Carlie made the motion to raise the price to \$7.00, seconded by Jamie. Motion passed.

Fair Campers: Sign up is March 28th, 2021 for leaders and families. Fairboard, Rodeo Sponsors, Sales Committee, Superintendents etc. need to get their money and form in to Jamie by March 10th please. Shan and Jamie will need a couple of people to help with traffic control. Steve and Chad volunteered.

Peggy will email the camper forms out. We can still use the lot by the courthouse annex.

Vendors: Peggy mailed out some vendor contracts.

Gate Fees: proposed gate fees this year.

Single Day Entry: Adult 18+ \$12.00, Senior Citizen 60+ and Youth 5-17 \$8.00

3-Day Weekend Pass: Adult 18+ \$30.00, Senior Citizen 60+ and Youth 5-17 \$20.00

3-Day Weekend Pass; Family 2-Adults and 4 Youth \$100.00

3-Day Leaders Pass: \$15.00

3-Day Vendor Pass: \$20.00

Under 5 is free.

A motion was made by Jamie to accept these gate fees, seconded by Tim. Motion passed.

Shan will need to buy wristbands to show that the hold harmless waiver has been signed, and for the 3-day weekend passes and the beer garden. OK to spend up to \$400.00. A motion was made by Jamie, seconded by Steve. Motion passed.

Parking: A proposal was made by the Asotin High School Safe and Sober Parents 2021 & 2022 to do the parking. Cost to park will still be \$5.00 it is a donation to the safe and sober party. Same work times. Fairboard will need to mark the lines in the parking lots and provide safety vest.

There will be no shuttle buses this year.

A motion was made by Jamie to accept this parking proposal, seconded by Carlie. Motion passed. Shan asked for a volunteer to contact Shawn Balzer to see if he can paint the parking lines this year. Peggy volunteered to call. Tim and Carlie will adjust the divider fence back some in the main parking lot.

Gates: Shan reached out to the Junior/Senior Clarkston High School Safe and Sober Parents to see if they will do the gates this year. The cost to pay someone to run and take money at the gates is \$3000.00. Waiting to hear back, will report at the next fairboard meeting.

Shan asked for a volunteer to oversee the cleaning of the tickets booths: Volunteers are LaNae, Peggy, Shan & Steve. Needs to Be done by April 19th.

Security: Peggy contacted the Asotin County Sheriffs Posse Search and Rescue to see if they would be interested in doing security during fair. They have a meeting coming up and will get back to Peggy.

Garbage Pickup: Tim is in charge of and would like to get the Rodeo Directors to help so we don't have that expense to pay out.

Entertainment: Shan, Tim, & Carlie are working on local entertainment for fair. Cindy was asked if she would contact the belly dancers and see if they are available and report back at the next meeting.

Contracts: Need to email Warren-Sales Committee the Livestock sale contract for this year. Peggy will email.

Shan asked Tammy G. if she can get hand sanitizers stands and email cost list to Shan.

Trophies: Barb reported that she has called a few people to see if they will sponsor again this year. Barb will contact Arlene to help call. Need to have everyone called by March 15th. Shan asked Barb to give her a list of the people who will sponsor again with name, address, email, what they are sponsoring and the cost. Shan will send out invoices and coordinate with Janice so money coming in

gets coded to correct line item. Barb reported that Ike has all the supplies needed to do the trophies. Barb will talk to Kim Belanger to see what trophies we will not need this year. We already have the belt buckles for this year, But will need to order one for the Beef Carcass contest.

It was decided to not do barn decorating this year. But will still need stall cards and pictures put up. The fairboard will not be able to reimburse anyone for decorations this year.

Open Class Exhibits: Need to talk to Arlene to contact the open class superintendents and see who is available to help.

Coca Cola: Peggy reached out to Coke. Talked to Nils about contract and Coke for Vendors.

TDS: will we need TDS this year for the extension office. Mark said he thought we did not because we should have a broader band width available now.

Judges: Mark will reach out to Cami and Glenn about Livestock Judges and talk to them about livestock and horse judging. Kim will contact for Still Life and Nicole for Horse Judge.

Work Days: need to start working at fairgrounds, starting to warm up. Table until next meeting. Need to get pipes fixed so we can get the water turned on. Need to fix water shed lid. Need to get a master list of projects that need to be done and leave in fair office for people to work on when they come out.

Fundraiser donation list updates: email to Moresa, Chad and Tammy. Steve reported that Agpro will donate up to \$500.00, Snake River Adventure-Boat Trip, and All Valley Fencing will donate. Email Donation Letter also.

Charlotte was asked if the fairboard can still use the Booster 501C3? Charlotte said she would ask and let us know.

Kids Rodeo: Rodeo board will have a meeting next week to continue working on planing for kids rodeo.

Charlotte asked about their storage shed, do they need a contract to have it on the fairgrounds. Yes we will need to do a contract with the fairboard and Cattle-women.

Old Business: Charlotte asked about the old cook shack what do we want to sale it for. We have multiple people interested in it. Not sure of the sale price as of yet. Charlotte said we could use her property on 4th street to put cook shack on if we need to. Cook shack needs a few new tires before it can be moved. Steve will reach out to Les Schwab and see about a donation for the tires.

Grand Marshals: need to have Arlene reach out to the Grand Marshals about the upcoming fair.

Charlotte: the roll-up window/door will be installed in March. Doug Renfro donated the framing.


Charlotte suggested we contact Dan Fowler he sings and plays the guitar and is good with kids for local entertainment ata fair.
