

Asotin County Fair Board Meeting Minutes April 8th, 2026

Call meeting to order 6:00pm- members present Nicole, Peggy, Jamie, Arlene, Britt, Nathan, Brian Called In

Royalty- Reece and Brooklyn presented their new purses from Erin Rice. Reece said recently they attended the Horseman's Ball. They have been working on their bust out practice to get ready for the fair and rodeo.

Open to the Public- Nel Murry represented the LC Valley Play Date group, which is a 501C3 group. They are asking if we are interested in donating some tickets to the fair to their group. Peggy said since we are a county entity we would need to discuss it with the county to see if we could donate. Jamie asked how many kids or adults would we be expecting through the gate. Nel said that it would depend on how many tickets we donated and if less than the number of kids then they would do a drawing. Peggy said we have a program where we charge \$5 per chaperone and kids would be free. Jamie made a motion we allow the kids in for free and chaperones in for \$5. Britt seconded, passed.

Cattle Women- Plant sale they would like to attach the sale flyers and banners to the fences. Jamie made a motion to allow, Nathan seconded, passed.

Extension Office- Jeanene said thanks for the handbook. Jeanene asked if there was a chance to review fair entry with the new superintendents. Peggy said if they can come out during a work day from 9am-12pm she can have a review with them. Jeanene also asked if there was someone that can help the swine superintendent with data entry.

Peggy- stated the swine judge has not sent back his contract and asked Jeanene to reach out to him.

Superintendents- Arlene had a meeting today with her superintendents and they need the stands moved to Floch hall.

Rodeo- Jamie said Kids Rodeo has multiple events that are full and all other kid's events are getting close to being full.

Nicole and Jeff- took signs down today for the non-sponsors. Jeff also reported Case is loaning us his tractor. Jamie said Case will deliver the tractor Monday of fair. Jeff said he needs to let Mitch know so that he can deliver the attachment for the tractor as the County tractor cannot pick it up.

Vendors- Rafter RH Hand tied halters was added.

Chris Seubert- Chris will not be at the fair or rodeo this year.

Old Business- Campers- Jamie reported we were able to take 9 &10 off our waiting list as some that were drawn passed and some sponsors didn't want a spot. Jamie asked if we had multiple people back out right before fair if we would need a special session to draw new alternatives. Peggy said yes.

Peggy- reminded everyone to be reviewing their job list assignments.

Peggy- said the handbook is out and the index is wrong.

EJ- went around and they have enough pig nipples for all the pens.

New Business- Hall Rentals- Janice is staying on until the end of May, after May, Peggy will take care of the rentals.

Nicole asked if we can create a calendar on the website that is more interactive for the arena.

Peggy talked to Kurt at Schurmans True Value and they can order tables for us at \$85.00 a table, normally \$125 a piece. He said the supplier has 20 in stock. Arlene made a motion that we get 20 tables from Schurmans, Nathan seconded, passed.

Arlene said the church was sold to the school and they have folding chairs available if we want them. Jamie and Peggy said we would take them if they are giving them away. Jamie said it would be good to get them and replace some of the broken ones.
